BUILDING HOMES FOR HEROES

Providing individuals, corporations and others with an opportunity to help our severely wounded and disabled veterans and their families rebuild their lives. Building Homes for Heroes is committed to supporting those who have returned home from the wars in Iraq or Afghanistan with severe wounds and disabilities, with a goal to build homes for families in dire need. It's our honor to support those who have been called upon to make a tremendous personal sacrifice.

Organizational Statement

Since 2006, Building Homes for Heroes has been at the forefront of making a significant



difference in the lives of the severely-wounded men and women of the military. We build homes from the ground up or modify existing homes to meet the needs of the brave men and women who have selflessly served our country. These mortgage-free homes not only help to remove the family's financial burden, they help to restore the individual's freedom, and enable the veteran to lead a more independent and productive civilian life.

During the fiscal year ended 12/31/2010, Building Homes for Heroes simultaneously worked on five home projects for severely-wounded veterans of the wars in Iraq or

Afghanistan. This includes completing projects that began in 2009, breaking ground on new projects, and selecting new recipients and searching for locations for their homes. Building Homes for Heroes expects to complete four home projects in 2011, and is optimistic about building or renovating 8-10 homes per year beginning in 2012.

Building Homes for Heroes operates with two compensated employees and hundreds of volunteers. Neither the president nor the board members are compensated. The organization strives to keep its overhead costs down and has been successful in achieving this goal. Building Homes for Heroes attained a program service percentage of **87% in 2010**. This figure measures the percentage of Building Homes for Heroes' expenditures that went directly toward program-related activities.

Building Homes for Heroes encourages the wounded veterans we have assisted, or are currently assisting, to travel to our events and take part in other organizational endeavors. Because these men and women are service-oriented individuals, they are pleased to support other Afghanistan and Iraq war veterans who have been severely injured. This enables the veteran to take another step toward being defined by their activities and not their injuries or disabilities.

THE LONE SAILOR MEMORIAL

Background: The **Central Florida Council**, under the leadership of Project Chairperson, Mike Phillips, TDCS, USN, ret., is raising funds to donate this patriotic statue to the city of Orlando to demonstrate gratitude to those who served, are serving and will serve in our sea services. Lone Sailors are all across the globe defending the United States of America, its families and its freedom as they have in the past and will continue in the future. The Lone Sailor patriotic statue expresses appreciation to the men and women all across the globe for voluntarily putting their lives at risk to protect freedom. The statue is meant to inspire youth and honor veterans. The Lone Sailor represents core values of honor, courage and commitment. Fifty percent of the proceeds raised will go to this worthy cause.

The statue will be located in Bluejacket Park in the old "grinder" area of the former Orlando NTC, Recruit Training Center (now Baldwin Park). The Lone Sailor Site will be available for use by all services, veterans organizations, and civic groups for appropriate special events, ceremonies and patriotic services. Donations are tax deductible.



THE STATUE

The bronze statue is the creation of Stanley Bleifeld, the U.S. Navy Memorial's official sculptor. The statue contains two pieces: the Sailor, who stands 7' tall and weighs approximately 1000 lbs., and his sea bag and cleat weighing 700 lbs. Currently there are 11 Lone Sailor sites throughout the United States. Let's bring the 12th home to Orlando, FL

As part of the casting process, the bronze for the Lone Sailor was mixed with artifacts from eight U.S. Navy ships provided by the curator for the Navy in the Naval Historical Center of the Washington Navy Yard. The ships span the Navy's history, yielding small pieces of copper sheeting, spikes, hammock hooks and other fragments from the post-revolutionary frigates the Constitution ("Old Ironsides") and the Constellation, the steamer Hartford, flagship of Admiral David G. Farragut in the Civil War era; the battleship USS Maine; the iron-hulled steamer/sailing ship USS Ranger; the World War II-era cruiser USS Biloxi and the aircraft carrier USS Hancock, as well as the nuclear-powered submarine USS Seawolf. One last addition was a personal decoration from today's Navy, one given to sailors in war and peace, the National Defense Service Medal. These bits of metal are now part of the Lone Sailor.
